

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Sarah Huff was born about 1804 in Pennsylvania. She was married November 16, 1823, in Pike County, Ohio, to Moses Sailor, the presumed son of Jeremiah and Christena (Kimball) Sailor.

Based upon family records, Moses and Sarah (Huff) Sailor were presumably the parents of Jeremiah Sailor, b. 15 April 1830 in Hancock County, Ohio. None of their sources prove that relationship.

RESEARCH QUESTION

Who were the parents of Sarah Huff?

Research Plan

1. Examine census records and/or census substitutes for evidence of Sarah Huff's birth parents.
2. Use census records to develop a timeline of events in the life of Sarah Huff.

Project 1: Possible Parents

Using census records, identify the possible parents for Sarah Huff who was born about 1804 in Pennsylvania and married Moses Sailor November 1823 in Pike County, Ohio.

LOCALITY BACKGROUND

On February 1, 1815, Pike County, Ohio, was largely organized from Ross and Scioto Counties, with a very small piece from the northeast corner of Adams County. Beaver Township, which was once part of Jefferson Township in Ross County, Ohio, was predominantly settled by pioneers from Pennsylvania, Virginia and a few from the Carolinas.

Project 2: Pennsylvania Huffs

Using census record substitutes, identify the Huff residents of Somerset County, Pennsylvania from 1795 to 1810.

LOCALITY BACKGROUND

Somerset County was created from Bedford County by a state legislative act approved 17 April 1795. The county was first organized into **six townships**:

Brother's Valley

Quemahoring (changed to Somerset in 1796)

Milford

Elk Lick

Stoney Creek

Turkey Foot

Addison township was organized in about 1800. It was largely created from the southeast section of Turkeyfoot township.

Project 3: Timeline Construction

Using census records ONLY, construct a timeline of life events for Moses Sailor, husband of Sarah (Huff) Sailor and son of Jeremiah and Christena (Kimball) Sailor, who was born about 1799 in Ohio and died 1876 in Angola, Steuben County, Indiana.
